Flexible Spending Accounts - The Division of Human Resources is pleased to provide you with important deadlines for flexible spending accounts, also known as a medical and dependent care reimbursement account, for the 2016 plan year.

Deadline to Use Funds - The grace period extended for 2016 plan year funds, to use or incur services for medical, limited purpose medical, and dependent care reimbursement accounts is **March 15, 2017**. **Filing Deadline (use it or lose it!)** - The filing deadline for all 2016 plan year claims is **April 15, 2017**. If services aren't used and claims aren't submitted by the deadlines, the benefit of these accounts and the money (see Section 125 of the IRS Tax Code) will be lost.


