As a way to keep the FIU community healthy during the upcoming flu season, FIU Health is once again offering the flu vaccine to faculty and staff. No appointment is needed, and there is no charge for the flu vaccine for those faculty and staff who are insured (just bring your photo ID and insurance card). If you are not insured, the cost will be \$20.00 (payable by check or cash). Vaccines will be available (while supplies last) at the two Faculty Group Practice (FGP) locations:
