Address Review & Update Reminder – The Division of Human Resources' Benefits Administration Department brings you this important update concerning your mailing address. In order to receive communication materials regarding your State-Sponsored Benefits, it is very important to keep your address on record up to date in our <u>PantherSoft System</u>. If you have experienced any changes in address, please update your information on file immediately. The address verification process in the People First system began on August 1, 2017. This annual process is necessary to ensure your current contact information is accurate within the State of Florida's People First portal. Click <u>here</u> for more information.

Optional Life Insurance Premium Change – The Benefits Administration Department brings you this important update concerning your Optional Life Insurance premiums, provided through Minnesota Life. The Optional Life Insurance premiums are calculated based on your age and salary. Take a step towards healthier eating and support local farmers! The Urban Vegetable Project (UVP) is a collaborative endeavor aimed at teaching underserved students the science, business, and art of sustainable farming practices, while providing locally grown food to the Miami community. After a successful spring season, UVP is bringing back its Community-Supported Agriculture (CSA) program, where community members pay a season subscription fee and receive a weekly box of vegetables harvested from UVP's urban farm.
