



- ✓ 9 over 12 month Deferred Earning Program Enrollment Period The 9 over 12 month Deferred Earning Program provides 9-month faculty an alternative option to receive payment of their salary over a 12-month period. This method of payment is available on an optional basis only and authorization is required from the faculty member. All 9-month faculty members will have the opportunity to select this payment option, or to disenroll, during the 9 over 12 month Deferred Earning Program. Enrollment period ends Friday, August 17th. - ✓ Dependent Eligibility Verification To ensure accountability in the state group insurance program, the Division of State Group Insurance (DSGI) has conducted a verification audit to confirm that an employee's dependents are eligible for insurance coverage. For enrollees who submitted partial documentation, the DSGI is reviewing the documents submitted and working to verify dependent eligibility when possible. Enrollees who did not respond to the audit, as well as those for whom DSGI cannot verify eligibility, will be mailed a letter providing them with administrative hearing rights prior to any dependents being removed from coverage. Enrollees will have 21 days to file a petition to challenge the removal of their dependents from coverage. Enrollees can submit an appeal to DSGI at any time to prospectively reinstate their eligible dependent's eligibility.
